Bisphenol A in baby bottles to be banned in Canada

Canadian health officials announced Saturday, Oct. 18, 2008 that bisphenol A is toxic and said they will ban baby bottles made with the chemical. The move, a first by any country, is giving fuel to those who want the chemical, found in plastic baby bottles and in the linings of cans, declared dangerous in the United States and elsewhere. Bisphenol A, developed as an estrogen replacement, is used to make hard, clear plastic. It's used commonly in baby bottles, the lining of food and beverage cans, CDs, eyeglasses and dental sealants. Studies in the past several years have linked it to cancer, heart disease, obesity, reproductive failures, autism and hyperactivity in laboratory animals.

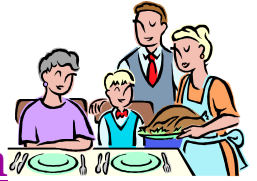
Worship service times are as follows:
